





Transfiguration Transcript

January 2026

God Wants Us to Have Well-Being

¹²So now, O Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you? Only to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, ¹³and to keep the commandments of the LORD your God and his decrees that I am commanding you today, for your own well-being (**Deuteronomy 10:12-13**).

⁷The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction (**Proverbs 1:7**).

²⁸Then they will call upon me, but I will not answer; they will seek me diligently, but will not find me. ²⁹Because they hated knowledge and did not choose the fear of the LORD (**Proverbs 1:28-29**).

*My child, if you accept my words and treasure up my commandments within you, 2 making your ear attentive to wisdom and inclining your heart to understanding; 3 if you indeed cry out for insight, and raise your voice for understanding; 4 if you seek it like silver, and search for it as for hidden treasures — 5 then you will understand the fear of the LORD and find the knowledge of God (**Proverbs 2:1-5**).*

⁷Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD, and turn away from evil (**Proverbs 3:7**).

¹³The fear of the LORD is hatred of evil. Pride and arrogance and the way of evil and perverted speech I hate (**Proverbs 8:13**).

¹³The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God, and keep his commandments; for that is the whole duty of everyone (**Ecclesiastes 12:13**).

¹A shoot shall come out from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots.

²The spirit of the LORD shall rest on him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.

³His delight shall be in the fear of the LORD (**Isaiah 11:1-3a**).

*Meanwhile the church throughout Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and was built up. Living in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it increased in numbers (**Acts 9:31**).*

God wants us to have well-being. To have well-being, we are to seek the knowledge of God which begins with the fear of the Lord. The fear of the Lord begins with acknowledging that God is God and we are not. When we forget this truth, our pride and arrogance take over to place ourselves above God. This idolatry causes us to pursue the ways of evil which promote self before God. To subdue the self, we must recognize the blessing of God's wisdom as revealed by God's word. God's word makes God known by teaching us the knowledge of God. This knowledge instructs us on how to live in proper relationship with God and others while also educating us on who Jesus is and why he matters. Trusting in this knowledge, we confess that God is God and we are not, so we are able to live in the fear of the Lord for greater well-being.
